## From the AGM of Bowls NZ - September 2019

### Major decisions affecting our club

#### **1. Affiliation Fees:**

The motion to change the method of collecting fees from clubs was passed with about an 80 % vote in favour. Instead of it being called a 'Capitation' fee, which meant a fixed fee per head of playing members, it is now an 'Affiliation Fee' charged to the club, and is not on a per player basis.

From the 2020 -21 financial year onwards the fees charged to clubs will be based on their membership as at 31 December 2018. This outcome means that clubs will be able to collect their total fee in any way they decide e.g. they could levy all of their members, not just playing members. They could levy associate, winter, social and casual members, or raise the fees in other ways - garage sales, raffles etc - if they choose to. Our club will need seriously to consider the options over the next year. Clubs with a large social membership e.g. Waikanae, will be able to spread the load more widely.

**<u>2. Types of Membership</u>** There were also motions to define types of 'Playing Membership' more accurately than was the case in the past. The new definitions are:

<u>"Playing Member</u>" means a person who wishes to enjoy the full playing and non-playing rights and privileges of being a member of a Club, including playing life members, and students. Only playing members are entitled to play at other affiliated Clubs and to enter Club Championships, Centre, Regional and/or National tournaments and events.

"Limited Playing Member" means a person who wishes to play bowls at their Club only. The rights and privileges of membership as a Limited Playing Member shall be specified in the Constitution, regulations and/or rules of the Club, but cannot extend beyond specific club tournaments and events. A Limited Playing member can only play in bowls events within the boundary of the physical club, and may not participate in club championships, centre or national events, or at any event at another bowling club.

"<u>Non-Playing Member</u>" means a person who does not play bowls but enjoy an ongoing association with a Club including participating in social activities at the Club, and includes non-playing life members.

"<u>Casual Member</u>" means a person who participates in any bowling event or competition held by or at a Club(s), Centre(s) or Bowls NZ in accordance with Rule 9.2(c) and becomes a Member for the period of that event or competition, and/or while present at the bowling venue. The rights and privileges of membership as a Casual Member shall be specified in the Constitution, regulations and/or rules of the Club,Centre or Bowls NZ (whichever is holding the event or competition) and/or as set out in the written agreement with the Casual Member to participate in the event or competition. Such a rule / agreement must comply with the Bowls NZ Regulations.

#### **Explanation:**

A number of clubs like ours already have member categories such as limited members, social playing members, business members, winter members etc. Bowls NZ regarded these members as "Playing Members" therefore they incur a membership fee (under the current system). They are not captured by the Non-Playing and Casual Member definitions as they can be entitled to play throughout the year, not just a one-off event. A new membership category, the Limited Playing Member has been added.

This really brings Bowls New Zealand into line with the definitions we use in our own club. It also reinforces our own ruling that our Limited Playing Members cannot expect to play at galas or tournaments at other clubs, or represent the club in any outside event.

## Half a Century of Bowls - Congratulations Noel

This year marks 50 years since a young, 37 year old **Noel** Larsen joined the Levin bowling club in 1969. Always a very competent lead Noel very early teamed up with **Ray Mitchell**, one of the club's outstanding players from the past. Together they won the pairs title at least 8 times the exact number is not known because the men's pairs honours board for that period of the 1980's has been lost. Ray won the singles 14 times and with Noel in the team they also won the triples and fours a number of times.

After Ray moved to Queensland Noel teamed regularly with I**an Wenham** and they won the pairs as recently as 2006-07.

Fifty years of continuous membership is a record few in New Zealand would be able to match. Noel is now a limited member but has already been down for his first roll up of the new season.
