Mark painted a rosy picture of the rising trend in bowls participation, both at membership level and at casual level. Substantial gains seem to have been made, particularly in relation to the trends in other organized sports. Whether this is the case in our centre is another story.

The Tournament Committee has made a number of changes to try to make more playing days available to clubs. Some changes will almost certainly happen to the Pennants competition to try to reduce the number of playing days, and to the detail of the Interclub competition.

The centre will also introduce time limits for all Open, C of C and Interclub events for the new season.

The three of us agreed that it was not a very positive meeting. Despite the optimism of Bowls New Zealand a number of clubs are struggling to find players willing to commit to competitions like Pennants and Interclub, and clubs found it hard to agree on new solutions. Time will tell if much real change occurs.
