The Bowls3Five Championship

It was good to see this event receiving more support from our players this season. We play it as a championship because there is a BKC C of C follow up with the winners going on to the national finals. Despite this support for our own event has not been great over the past two years when only 4 - 5 teams entered and it was run as a round-robin and able to be completed in one day.

The programmers again scheduled this season's event as a one day event as it was believed that the event did not have much appeal to the players. Wrong; this year it attracted eight teams and the round-robin could not be achieved in one day. Five rounds were played on 23 November and after consulting players for their availability the final two rounds were played on 17 December: The main results were:

For the future. The Format Guide for our 'Major Championships' (those that go on to C of C's) are clearly stated on Page 43 of our handbook. Round-robins are played with 5 or fewer entries. For more than 5 entries play can be 2 out of 3 wins, or play in Sections of Four.

To complete the event in one day with more than 5 entries play could be in two sections of 4 or 5 depending on the number of entries with the winners of each section playing off in a final on the day. The aim is to find a winner. The most efficient way to achieve that may be to play in sections.
