Corrections to Your Handbook

Limited Playing Membership

In case there is any confusion about the playing and general rights of Limited Playing Members this is the statement from the Club Constitution adopted by the club in April 2025.

Limited Playing Members:

All Limited Playing Members shall:

- a) be entitled to such privileges and advantages of membership of the Club as determined by the Board;
- b) be entitled to play in approved bowls events within the boundaries of the physical club;
- c) not be entitled to participate in club, centre or national events that progress to a centre or national championship;
- d) be entitled to participate in any event at any other bowling club, provided the other bowling club permits such participation:
- e) be entitled to hold office in the Club; and
- f) be entitled to speak and vote at General Meetings of the Club.

Substitutes in Team Events

A Bowls NZ working party has been reviewing the rules related to Substitutes in team games. Up until now it has been left up to each controlling body (465 clubs, 27 centres) to grant substitutes. This is quite impractical and causes many problems.

The outcome is that f<u>rom 1 September 2025</u> the reason for granting a Substitute is no longer subject to a controlling body's approval, and that instead there will be a blanket acceptance of the reasons for a substitute providing that:

- There are still the required number of players from the Original team (2 players from the Original team for Fours, 1 player for Pairs and Triples
- The substitute shall not be the skip, and
- The equal or lesser player qualifier is respected, meaning that the team is no better than it would have been in the first instance.

Note: The Original Team are the players who are members of the team when the jack is delivered on the first end of the first game to be played by the team in a competition.
