Farewell Arne Jansson

Arne Jansson made a great contribution over a quarter of a century of membership of our club. He joined Levin from the Central club in the 1999 - 2000 season. In his working life he had been a shepherd, the owner of a Levin auction business, and more recently a valued member of the Higgins contracts team.

Arne became the greenkeeper at our club more than a decade ago when the club decided to do without a paid greenkeeper. He very quickly built a team of club volunteers who took over the responsibility of mowing, rolling and doing all the work of preparing the *cotula* green for play under Arne's guidance. It is fair to say that this model was so successful that within two years the *cotula* green quickly became the best playing surface in the centre. In fact Arne was rewarded as the Bowls Kapiti Coast *Greenkeeper of the Year* for 2016-17, and again for the following season.

It was a major loss for the club when three years ago we were advised that the green was infested with a pest that the chemicals used to eradicate it were no longer available, and we were advised to replace the green with a carpet.

On the green Arne was among the best few skips in the club and usually skipped the Interclub Premier I fours team. Arne won nine club titles in triples and fours at our club and was a very popular, and highly respected, club member. We will all miss Arne.
