Rule 40 Skips Duties 40.1.10

Skips can at any time delegate their own powers and any of their duties (except those of Law 40.1.7) to any other members of the team so long as they tell the opposing skip immediately.

40.1.7

The skip MUST be responsible for the card.

Appendix A 4 Restricting the movement of players during play

A 4.1.1.1

... a Singles player can walk up to the head after delivery of their third and fourth bowls.

But

A 4.2 In exceptional and limited circumstances, a Singles player can ask the marker for permission to walk up to the head...)

(This makes sense as in all team games the player has someone on the head to advise them of the situation of the head.)

And, More Rules with Jules!

This month **Umpire Julie** hopes that the following guide to the Laws will help our less experience players sort out the differences between *Practice Ends* and *Trial Ends* which has caused some confusion recently.

Practice Ends These can take place if a player or team is due to meet a player or team that has already played on the same day.

Law 4. Practice Ends

- 4.1 If a player/team that has not yet played is due to met a player/team that has already played on the same day, the player/team that has not yet played can practice as long as:
- 4.1.1 The Controlling Body (CB) gives its approval.
- 4.1.2 There is enough time without delaying the start of play.
- 4.1.3 Another rink is available apart from that which the player/team has been drawn to play on later that day.
- 4.2 If a player/team has already played in the same green on the same day, that player/team can practice with Law 4.1 if they have a bye.
- 4.3 The CB must allocate the rink.
- 4.4 If two teams are entitled to practice they can practice together.

Trial Ends These take place before the start of play in a game but only once in a day.

Law 5. Trial Ends

- 5.1.1 Before the start of play in any game, or before continuing an unfinished game on another day, one trial end must be played in each direction.
- 5.1.2 For domestic play, the CB can limit the number of trial ends to be played.
- 5.1.3 Trial ends must be played on the same rink that the game will be played on.
- 5.1.4 Each player must use not more than the number of bowls being used for the game. If a player or Umpire notices that a player is using more than the permitted number of bowls, the defaulting player will lose the right to play any bowls remaining to be played in the trial ends.
- 5.1.5 Each player can use any combination of bowls taken from different sets of bowls.
- 5.1.6 The opponents of the team which started the first trial end must start the second trial end.
- 5.1.7 When each bowls comes to rest, any player or marker can remove it and place it towards the front of the ditch.
- 5.1.8 If a bowl moves the jack, the jack must be put back to its former position.
