This is the 31st year of Business House Bowls at Levin Bowls

32 Teams of Casual members (approximately 136 players this year) are enjoying this year's 10-week tournament.

When the tournament started the format was 2 bowlers and 1 non bowler. After a few years it was changed to 1 bowler and 2 non bowlers and now all the players are non-bowlers. They are however given a Casual Membership card which entitles them to use of the club's facilities. Two games a night are played starting 5.45pm, a meal (at a very reasonable cost) is served and a well patronised bar helps our clubs' finances. The teams are well organised. But without the club volunteer helpers 'where would we be.'

Brian Cooper is 'the boss', Hazel Rose does 'grading and recording' and Trevor Turnbull the 'Teams organiser.' Kitchen, bar and helpers around the greens give up their time for the 10 evenings to support the Tournament and our club.

It would be interesting to know if any other Bowling clubs in NZ have had a continuous event for casual - barefoot bowlers over such a period of time?

A National Champion from the Kāpiti Coast

The National Fours and Mixed Pairs titles were decided in Central Otago recently. There were a few local players taking part - **Diana McGill** and **Trevor Tuatara**, **Chris** and **Michelle Macdonald** (Raumati) in the Mixed Pairs, but the standout by far was **Lisa White** (Paekakariki / Raumati) with her partner **Dean Gilshnan** (Manawatu). Lisa and Dean played some very good pairs to qualify and in post-section, no more so than in the final where they met the two players who won the National singles titles this year, **Selina Goddard** and **Sheldon Bagrie-Howley** who they defeated 15 - 9.

So it was a first national title to come to the Kāpiti Coast centre since 2009 when **Ray Boffa** won the pairs in a composite team with **Rob Ashton**. Earlier in 2006 **Audrey Stevenson** won the singles and **Rex Holmes** and **Brian Howman** triumphed in the pairs in Wellington.

And, the local links did not end there as former Levin Bowls member **Raika Gregory** skipped a four from Ngaruawahia to the runner-up spot losing a close final to Rodney Greaney's composite team from Canterbury / South Canterbury. Raika grew up in Otaki playing bowls with his dad Gene from a very young age. They played at our club for a couple of seasons when Raika was a teenager in the early 2000's before they moved to the Waikato.

Representative Bowls

The Kapiti Coast rep. teams took part in the Senior Octagonal and Junior Hexagonal tournaments played in Taranaki and Manawatu over the weekend 10-12 February. The results were not great for our teams with the exception of the senior women who finished a close third in the 6 team competition involving Gisborne-East Coast, Hawkes Bay, Wairarapa, Wellington, Taranaki, Wanganui, Manawatu and Kapiti Coast.

For the senior women playing at the Paritutu club it was singles player **Marei Bevan**, who won 6 of her 7 games, and the pair of **Audrey Stevenson** and **Jane Selby-Paterson** with 6 ½ wins, who led the way. The triples and fours could not match those results so the team finished with 16 wins from 28 games played. The event was won by Wellington with Kapiti Coast third.

The senior men played at the West End club and finished last in the competition with 10 wins from 28 games. Our former players Stacey Thomas, Nicki Morgan and Peter Brown played in the pairs and triples. The event was won by the very strong Wellington team.

The junior women played at the Palmerston North club. Gisborne-East Coast and Wairarapa did not take part so it was a six team competition. Our reps were **Elisabeth Glinkowska** who had a very tough time in the singles, **Erica Whittaker** skipped the triples and they won 3 of their 5 games while **Chloe Eastham** and **Mary Van** played in the fours and won 2 games. Overall the team finished sixth winning 6 of their 20 in the event which was won by Hawkes Bay. I don't know the reason why but our team was made up only of 5 years and under players, whereas it was open to 8 years and under which placed our team at quite an experience disadvantage.

The junior men played at Hawera Park and was way off the pace against strong opposition from the other five centres. The team won only 3 of 20 games to finish sixth. The event was won by Wellington. I have to wonder why there was no place for our top juniors **Jim Winter** and **Phil Stirrat** whereas second year players Adam Batty and Iraia Peni, familiar to our members, from Central, made the team. Maybe they were unavailable.

The Women's Singles Championship

Congratulations to **Bella Law** on winning her second Women's Singles title when she beat **Elisabeth Glinkowska** 21 - 14 in a closely contested final. In the semi-finals Elisabeth had beaten **Bronwyn McMahon** and Bella beat **Kay Hogan**.

Our women were most impressed with the way Match Committee duty member **Wayne Judd** ran the competition. In the words of one of the appreciative players:
